

The Russell County Commission
Meeting Minutes
November 12th, 2008
10:00 A.M. EST.

The Russell County Commission Meeting was called to order by Chair Person Peggy Martin.

The invocation was given by Wesley Price, Pastor of Cottonton Baptist Church.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Martin.

Chair Person Martin welcomed Elected Officials, Department Heads, Media and Visitors.

Alford Harden, the Judge of Probate, administered the Oath of Office to the Commissioners for their new term of office.

The roll was called; Commissioners present were District 1, Gentry Lee; District 2, Tillman Pugh; District 3, Peggy Martin; District 4, Ronnie Reed; District 5, Cattie Epps; District 6, Mervin Dudley; District 7, Larry Screws. Also present were the County Attorney, Kenneth Funderburk and the County Administrator, LeAnn Horne who kept the minutes.

A quorum was established.

Chair Person Martin requested approval of the November 12th, 2008 agenda. Commissioner Lee made a motion to approve the agenda and was seconded by Commissioner Dudley. The vote to approve was unanimous.
