

The Russell County Commission
Meeting Minutes
April 11, 2012
9:30 A.M. EDT

Public Comments:

Zuleyda Horner complained about how the Office Manager of the Russell County Water Authority treated her while she was trying to get information on application requirements for garbage service.

Probate Judge Alford Harden announced there will be a run-off election for the District 7 Commission seat. Judge Harden reminded residents to vote.

An adjourned Russell County Commission Meeting was called to order. Members present were: Chair Peggy Martin, Vice Chair Cattie Epps, Gentry Lee, Tillman Pugh, Ronnie Reed, Mervin Dudley and Larry Screws. Also present were the County Attorney Kenneth Funderburk and County Administrator LeAnn Horne who kept the minutes.

A quorum was established.

Chair Martin requested a motion to approve meeting agenda. Commissioner Epps motioned to approve the agenda; seconded by Commissioner Reed. The vote was unanimous.

The invocation was given by Wason Carroll, Associate Pastor of Central Baptist Church.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Lee.

Chair Martin welcomed elected officials, department heads, media and visitors.

Chair Martin also requested a motion approving the March 28th, 2012 meeting minutes. Commissioner Dudley motioned to approve the minutes and was seconded by Commissioner Lee. The vote was unanimous.

Sheriff Taylor stated he gave the Jail report at Monday night's work session and requested for it to be stricken from the agenda. His request was approved.

The County Administrator stated that the April 23rd, 2012 work session falls on a State holiday which the Courthouse will be closed. Commissioner Lee motioned to cancel the work session and was seconded by Commissioner Pugh. The vote was unanimous.

Chair Martin announced the Widest Yard Sale will be held May 31-June 2. The sales will extent from Phenix City Hwy 80 W to Cuba, Alabama.

The No Burn Ban will begin May 1st and will be in effect until November 1.

Commissioner Lee announced the Starlight Dance will be held April 21st at the old Seale Courthouse. Tickets are \$25.00 per person.

Sheriff Taylor stated a charity football game between the Sheriff's Department and the High School Seniors and Coaches will be held Friday April 13th, at 2:00 p.m. on the Russell County High School Field. This is a fundraiser for the school's sports program.

Wanda Lamb invited the public to the Ladonia Volunteer Fire Department Saturday, April 14th, for a community fun day hosted by Little Eyes are Watchers Too, a neighborhood watch program. This event is free to the public.
