APPROPRIATE DRESS IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRY INTO THE JUSTICE CENTER

LISTED BELOW ARE THE THINGS THAT ARE NOT APPROPRIATE AS COURTROOM APPAREL.

NO SAGGING PANTS/NO SPANDEX	NO RIPPED OR TORN JEANS
NO MINISKIRTS/NO SHORTS	NO MUSCLE SHIRTS or T-Shirts with inappropriate pictures
NO HALTER TOPS/FLIP FLOPS	NO PLUNGING NECKLINES
NO BARE MIDRIFTS	NO PAJAMAS
NO HATS	NO SUNGLASSES

ALL CELL PHONES MUST BE TURNED OFF BEFORE ENTRY INTO THE BUILDING. NO TEXTING OR COMMUNICATION WITH OTHERS IN THE COURTROOM.

CHILDREN IN THE COURTROOM:

Given the formal nature of court proceedings, it is NOT RECOMMENDED FOR INFANTS OR SMALL CHILDREN to attend unless subpoenaed. CHILDREN SHOULD BE MONITORED AND NOT LEFT TO RUN AROUND THE BUILDING AND HALLWAYS.
